Game can be played with 1 or more players.


Set Up

Directions

- 1. Print two sets of cards.
- 2. Use the dotted lines to cut out each card.
- 3. Shuffle the two sets of cards together.
- 4. Arrange the cards face-down on a flat surface like the **Set Up** example.
- 5. The first player turns over two cards.
 - a. If the two cards match, that player keeps those two cards and has another turn, see **Example a**.
 - b. If the cards don't match, replace them face-down in the same place, see **Example b**.
- Players continue taking turns until all cards are matched. Player with the most matches is the winner.
