College Internship Program 2009



Longwood Gardens offers excellent internship opportunities for college/university students to gain practical experience, develop professional and horticultural skills and study horticulture in one of the world's premier public display gardens.

Longwood Gardens is located within driving distance of three major cities: Philadelphia, New York, and Washington D.C. The Gardens consists of 1,050 acres, including four acres of conservatories and 20 outdoor gardens.

Each intern specializes in one of 14 horticulture or education internship areas throughout the garden. Internship opportunities range in length from three to 12 months.

A typical week includes four-and-a-half 8-hour work days and one half-day learning activity, including field trips, lectures, workshops, and/or self-guided study.

Interns receive a taxable stipend of \$8.50 per hour and typically work 40 hours per week.

Student housing is provided rent-free to all College Interns and is located within walking distance of most work areas.
