








Conifer (Gymnosperm) Leaf Types Quick Reference

<p><i>Abies</i>, <i>Picea</i>, <i>Cedrus</i>, <i>Pseudotsuga</i>, <i>Taxus</i>, <i>Pinus</i></p>		<p><i>Picea abies</i></p> 
Pine needles	Needle bundle	Example
<p>In <i>Pinus</i>, needles may occur in bundles, or fascicles of 2, 3, 2 and 3, or 5.</p>		<p><i>Pinus strobus</i></p>
